MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

Warning!

We strongly recommend to let an Öhlins dealer install this product.

Warning!

If you work with a lifted vehicle, make sure that it is safely supported to prevent it from tipping over.

Note!

When you work with this product, see the vehicle service manual for vehicle specific procedures and important data.

Note!

Before you install this product clean the vehicle.

1

Put the motorcycle on a work stand so that the rear wheel barely touches the ground.

2

Remove the seat and the plastic covers around the fuel tank.

3

Loosen the fuel tank and, lift the rear about 100 mm.

4

Loosen the rear brake fluid reservoir.

5

Loosen the 4 mounting bolts for the rear sub frame. Remove the lower bolts so that you can lift the sub frame when you remove and install the shock absorber.

6

Loosen the lower and upper attachment bolts to remove the original shock absorber. You may need to loosen the bolt that connects the pull rods and the triangle link to get access to the lower shock absorber bolt.

Caution!

Carefully lift the rear sub frame to avoid damage to the hoses or wire harnesses when you remove and install the shock absorber.

Install the Öhlins shock absorber in the same position as the original shock absorber.

8

Install all removed parts in the same positions as they were before removal.

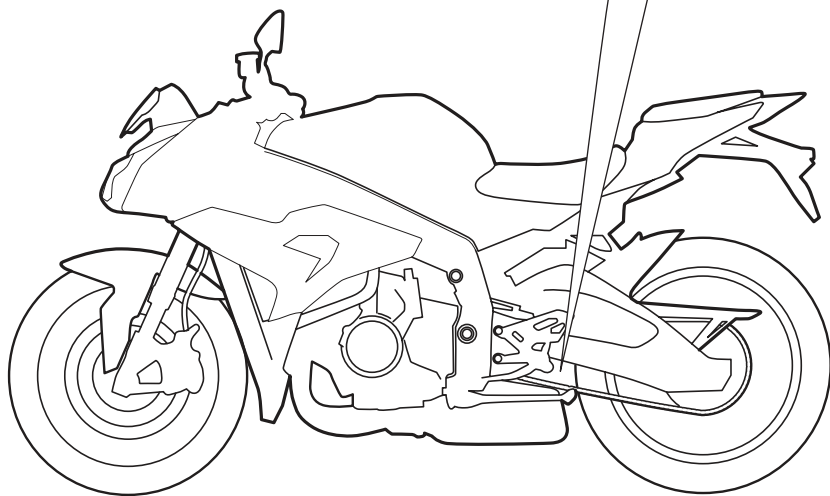
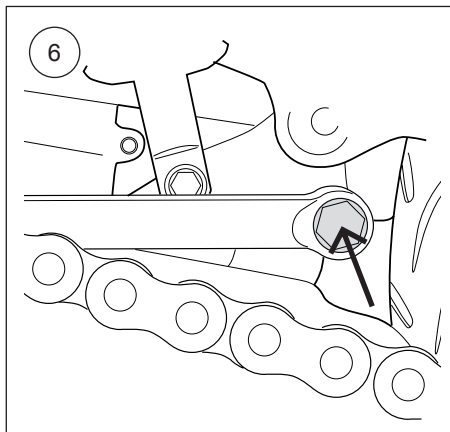
Note!

Lower the vehicle so that the suspension is slightly compressed before you tighten the screws.

Caution!

Make sure that you tighten all screws to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber/front fork/steering damper when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.

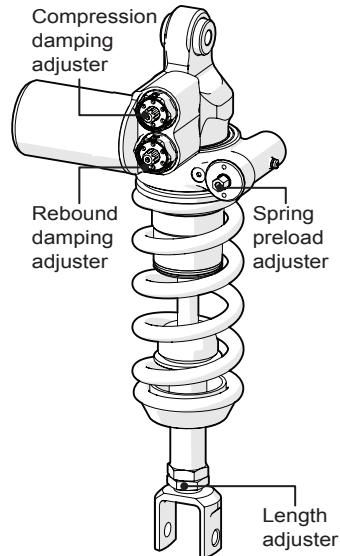
